  - b. Pray for the Lord's guidance.
  - c. Trust the Lord to show you your gifts and how you can be most effective in building up the Body of Christ. Be humble and realize these gifts are from the Lord there is nothing you have done to deserve them and they are for the benefit of the Body of Christ.
- 2. <u>Take the Assessment.</u>
  - a. Answer the questions as honestly as you can do not try to make the results have any specific outcome.
  - b. Answer each question on the answer sheet, using the numbers that best match your experience.
- 3. Score the Assessment.
  - a. Add the numbers across the row.
  - b. Circle the top five highest scoring gifts.
  - c. Mark the lowest five scoring gifts.
- 4. <u>Review the Assessment.</u>
  - a. On the "My Summary" sheet, record the highest (strongest) and lowest (weakest) scoring gifts.
  - b. Make a copy for you and for at least two other people with whom do a reality check.
